

Fire has to spread warmth and light and also to burn. These are its Dharma. Without them, it is but coal. Sugar without the sweet taste is but paltry powder. A rose without fragrance might as well be a plastic substitute. Man's Dharma is to love and serve fellowmen, practicing truth without causing injury to others.
